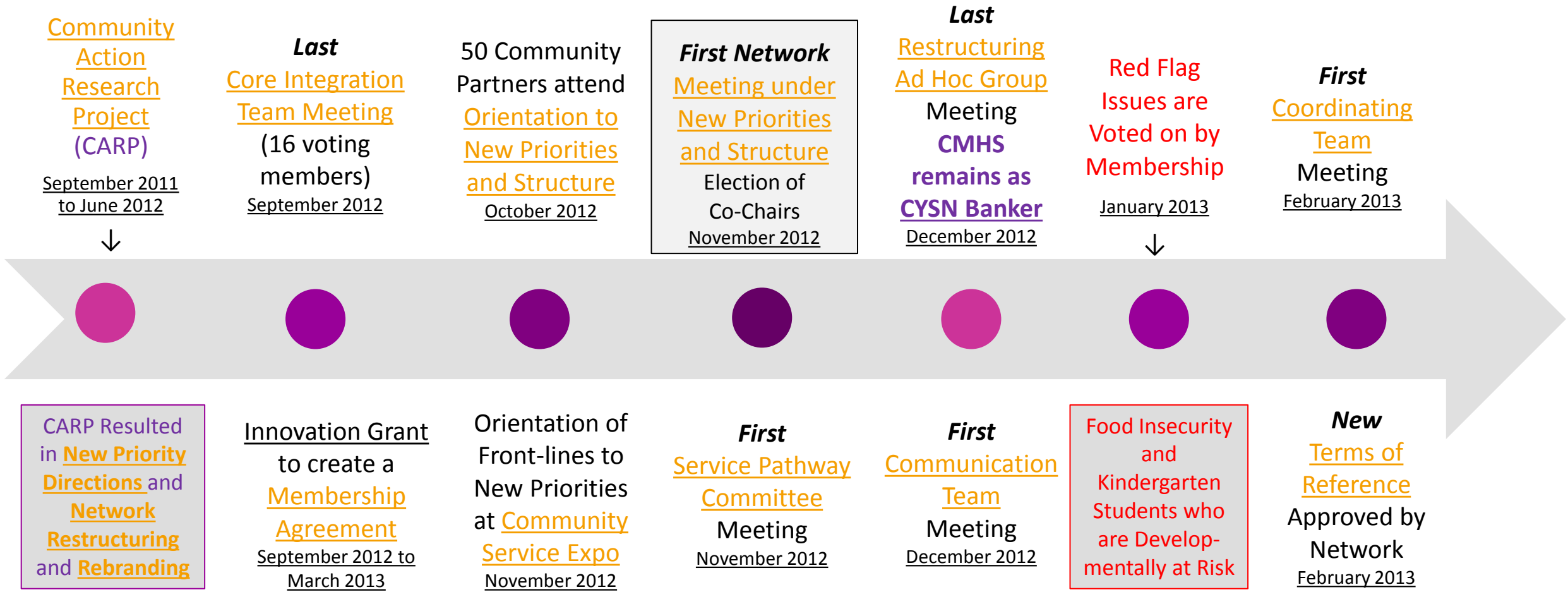
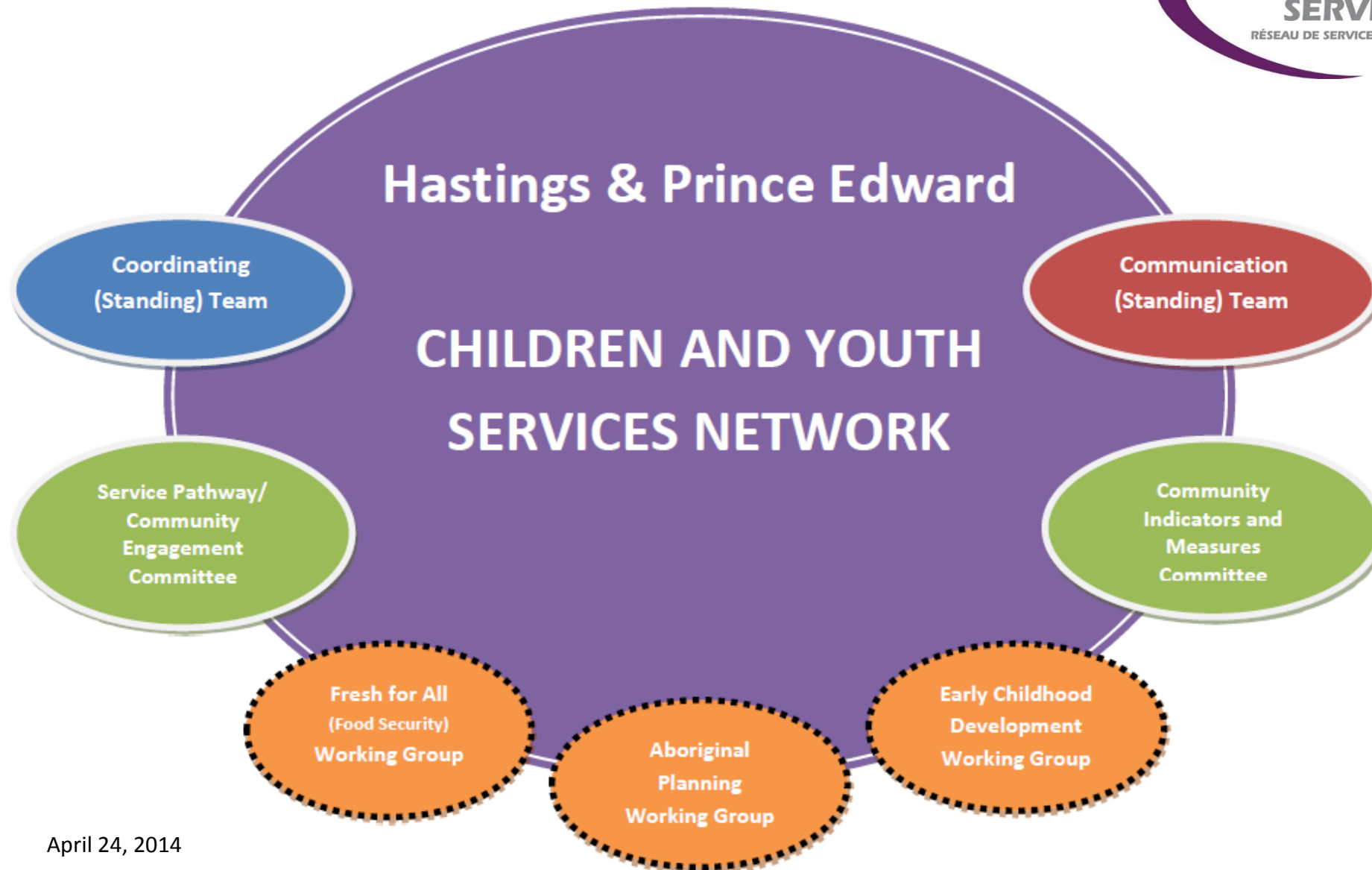


CYSN Historical Timeline 2011 - 2017

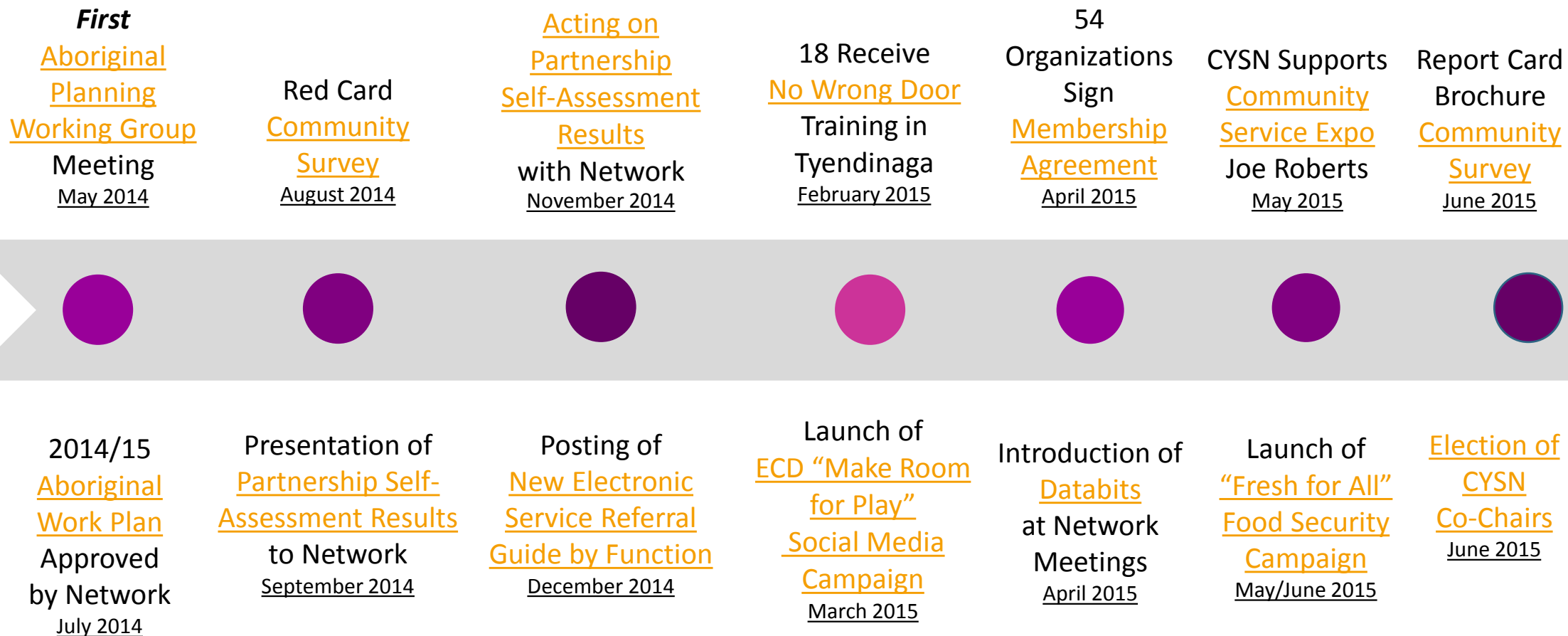

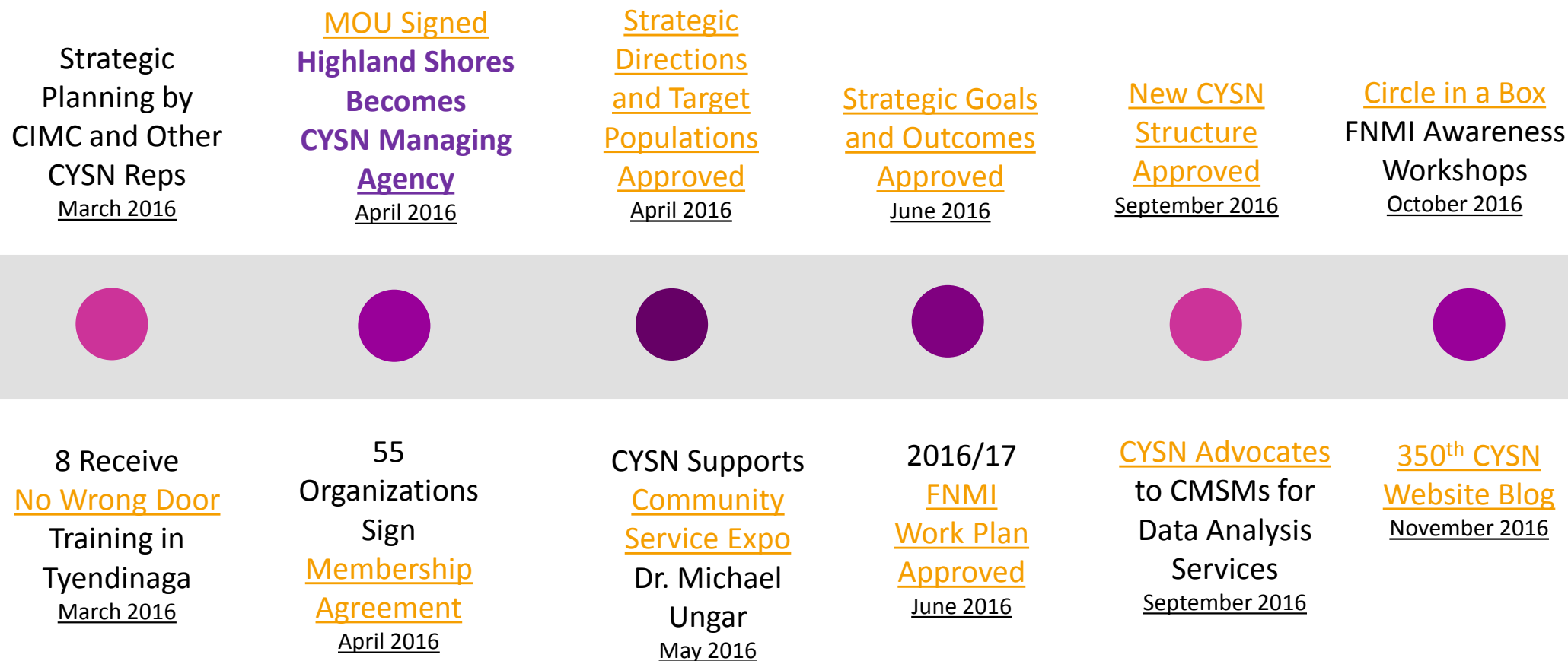

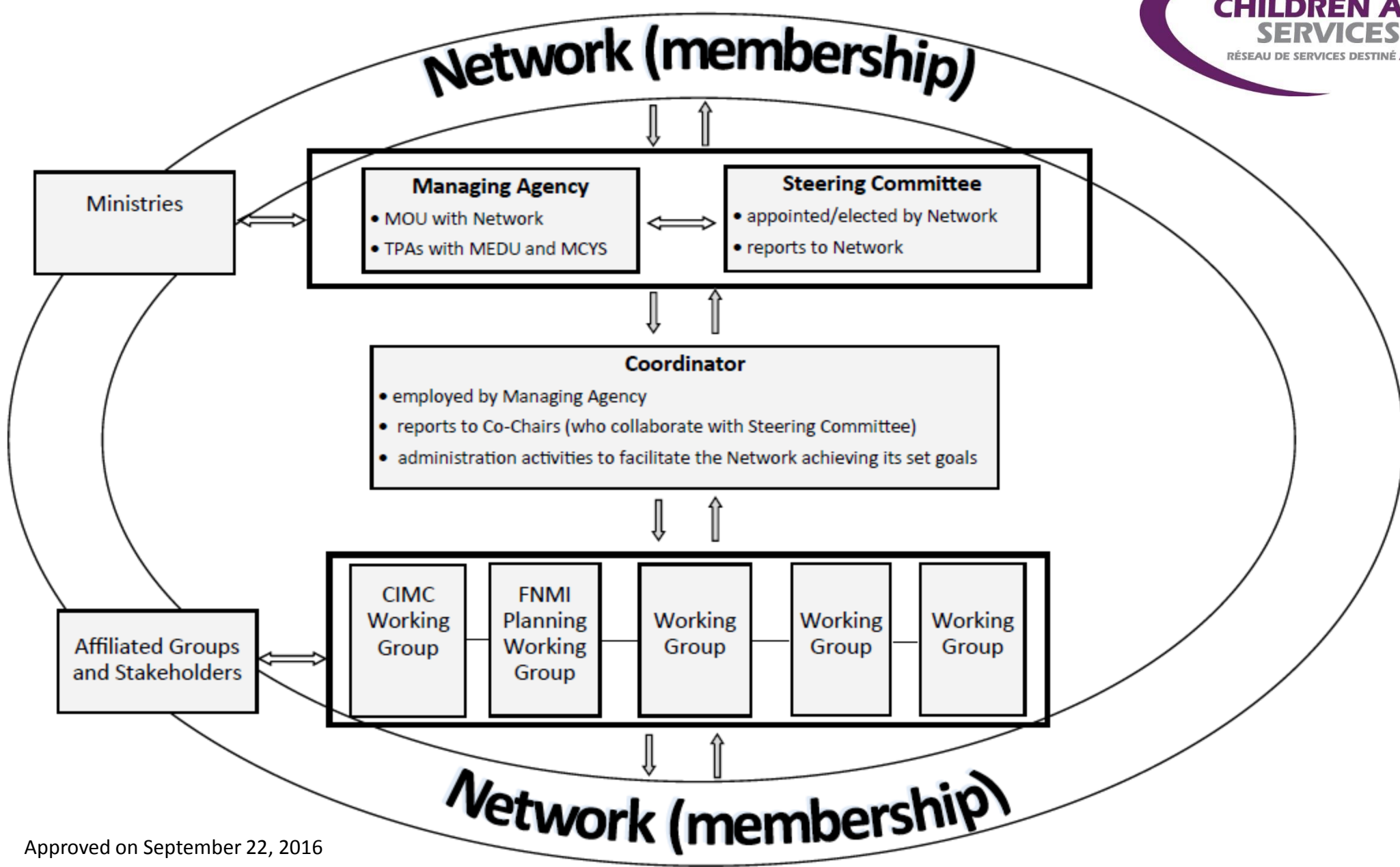

CYSN Historical Timeline 2011 - 2017



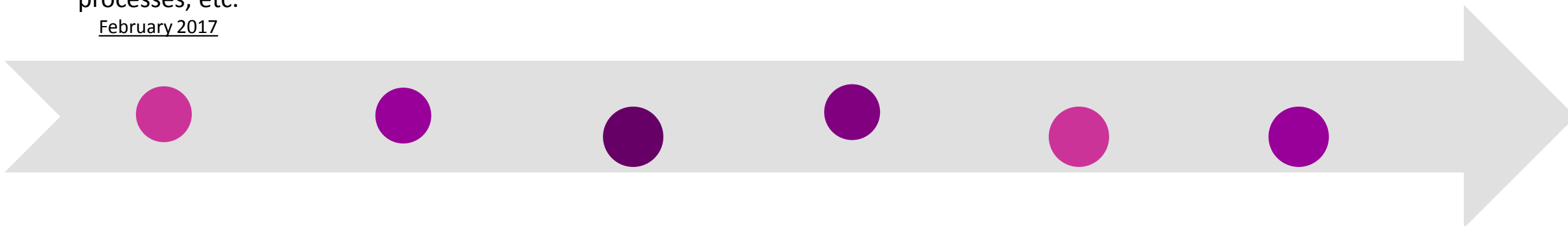
